

**BRAIN RULES**

**6. ATTENTION**

The brain is a sequential processor, unable to pay attention to two things at the same time. Businesses and schools praise multitasking, but research clearly shows that it reduces productivity and increases mistakes. Try creating an interruption-free zone during the day—turn off your email, phone, and social-media sites—and see whether you get more done. If you have trouble untangling yourself download software that blocks your access to certain websites for the amount of time that you specify.

*Divide presentations into 10-minute segments*

Remember my students who said they got bored after 10 minutes into a mediocre lecture? The 10-minute rule, which researchers have known for many years, provides a guide to creating presentations people can pay attention to. Here's the model I developed for giving a lecture, for which I was named the Hoechst Marion Roussel Teacher of the Year (awarded at one of the largest annual meetings in psychiatry).

I decided that every lecture I'd ever give would be organized in segments, and that each segment would last only to minutes. Each segment would cover a single core concept—always general, and always explainable in one minute. The brain likes meaning before detail, and the brain likes hierarchy. Start with general concepts naturally leads to explaining information in a hierarchical fashion. Give the general idea first, before diving into details, and you will see a 40 percent improvement in understanding.

Each class was 50 minutes, so I could easily burn through five large concepts in a single period. I would use the other nine minutes
